DIRECT RENEWAL RESPONSE Results from the last dues notice have been arriving at a steady pace, but your help is certainly needed to reach the goal for 2021. Commander Wooten has established a very realistic goal and is counting on every officer to ask every eligible veteran in your community to join THE AMERICAN LEGION.

CONSOLIDATED POST REPORT FORM Now is a good time to start recording the various activities in which your Post is involved and keeping track of donations and other expenses. You will then have the information available when you file the Consolidated Post Report form. The CPR form will be sent to Adjutants next spring. Commander Wooten expects 100% participation from all the Posts. The CPR can be submitted electronically by using MyLegion.

CONTINUOUS MEMBERSHIP RECOGNITION National Headquarters prepares certificates of recognition early each year for members credited on the data records with 50, 60, 70, 75, 80 and 85 years of continuous membership as of January 1, 2021. National sends the certificates directly to Post Commanders for distribution to honored members, often times at the Post Birthday event in March. Certificates will be mailed in February per National. Please notify Department Headquarters if you have problems in receiving certificates for your Post.

HOLIDAY BLOOD DONOR DRIVE December is The American Legion's observance of a special effort to promote blood donor participation. Please encourage your members to donate when the Bloodmobile is scheduled in your area. Ask donors to let you know the amount they donated for use in the CPR.

TOURNAMENT HOSTS The Department Athletic Committee will be honoring the host sites selected in 2020 for the 2021 season unless there is a vacancy caused by a Legion Baseball rule or the host turned it back in. Please check our website or call Headquarters to see if your Area has a vacancy and for the form. Be sure to read all the requirements before submitting the application. In order to be considered for a tournament, the bid form **MUST BE RECEIVED** by the Programs Director no later than January 8th.
